MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE CHAIRMAN

The month of July has produced its customary feast of [top class racing in GB](#) at the Newmarket July Meeting, the July Festival at Ascot, and at Glorious

Goodwood – the highlight of which was Champion trainer Sir Michael Stoute saddling the first three home in the Gr.1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes. While at the Curragh, [Sariska \(GB\)](#) completed a magnificent Oaks double.

The Levy Board's recent announcement regarding Prize Money in 2010 was cause for concern – but countered by confirmation of the new [Racing Post Yearling Bonus Scheme](#). A magnificent example of 'self help', at a time of world economic uncertainty – and a glowing compliment to the Breeze Up Bonus Scheme, which has proved so successful this year. Both Schemes are supported and promoted by both BBM and ITM.

BBM and Tattersalls made a brief but productive joint visit to [Bangalore](#) (10-12 July), the express intention being to publicise the lifting of the ban on the importation of bloodstock from UK to India.
